

2011-2012


- Hosted vacation bible school (January 2011)

- **Broke ground** for Community Center in Community II (November 2012)



- Continued home construction in Community II (all year)
- The 'Mock Plan' is instated; foundations are poured for 23 foundations and utility poles installed in phase II of Community II (October 2015)
- Child Abuse Awareness seminars are hosted throughout the region (January – February 2016)
- **Well installed** in community I to address ongoing water issues (January 2016)
- Baseball field construction begins (January 2016)
